MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT***

**RIVERSIDE COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT,
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1.0 PURPOSE

The Riverside County Probation Department (Probation), in cooperation with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department (Sheriff); City Police Agencies (Police) of the Cities of Banning, Beaumont, Cathedral City, Desert Hot Springs, Hemet, Indio, Murrieta, Palm Springs, and Riverside; the Riverside County District Attorney (DA); and the Unified School Districts (USD) of Alvord, Banning, Beaumont, Corona/Norco, Coachella, Desert Sands, Hemet, Jurupa, Lake Elsinore, Moreno Valley, Murrieta, Palm Springs, Perris, Riverside, San Jacinto, Temecula and Val Verde, herein referred to as All Parties, enter into this interagency Memorandum of Agreement (MOA). This MOA provides the mechanism, and defines the roles and responsibilities, through which these agencies will work together to accomplish the mutual goal of providing services for the AB1913 Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) Youth Accountability Team (YAT) Program located throughout Riverside County.

All Parties agree to the following roles, responsibilities, and accompanying terms and conditions, which will be effective immediately and remain in effect until terminated or modified as defined in section 4.0 of this MOA.

2.0 SCOPE

This MOA shall apply to the YAT Program to provide a multi-agency system of swift and fair responses for at-risk youth and their families. All Parties will endeavor to work with at-risk youth in a combined effort to reduce such things as truancy, delinquent incidents on school campuses, delinquent incidents in the community, the number of youth in custody, the number of court petitions, and the level of substance abuse at school and in the community.

Although all YAT staff work in a collaborative fashion and strive to reach consensus on major decisions affecting a youth's participation in the program, the Deputy Probation Officer (DPO) leads the team and is ultimately responsible for supervision of YAT youth. As reflected in the terms of this MOA, all critical aspects of supervision rest solely with the DPO (intake decisions, establishing appropriate rehabilitative plans, and ensuring compliance with behavior contracts or consequence agreements).

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1 **3.0 TERM**

2 This MOA shall be effective upon execution by the authorized signatory of All Parties. This
3 MOA shall be effective through June 30, 2018. Thereafter this MOA will automatically
4 renew, annually, for each entire fiscal year from July 1 to June 30 and shall remain in
5 effect for no more than five years unless terminated or modified as defined in section 4.0
6 of this MOA.

7
8 **4.0 AMENDMENT OR TERMINATION OF MOA**

9 This MOA, along with any incorporated attachments, fully expresses all understandings of
10 the parties concerning all matters covered and shall constitute the total MOA. No addition
11 to, or alteration of, the terms of this MOA whether by written or verbal understanding of
12 the parties, their officers, agents or employees, shall be valid unless made in the form of a
13 written amendment to this MOA formally approved and executed by All Parties.

14
15 This MOA may be amended at any time with the written concurrence of All Parties.
16 Consideration for amendment will be given upon written notification by one party to
17 Probation as the lead agency. Probation will facilitate an All Parties review for
18 amendment. All Parties will review this MOA at least annually and modify as needed.

19
20 Any party may discontinue participation with or without cause upon thirty (30) days
21 written notification to Probation. The termination of the notifying party's participation
22 will take effect thirty (30) days following receipt of the written notice of termination. The
23 MOA will remain in effect for Probation and all remaining agencies.

24
25 This MOA can be terminated with or without cause by Probation upon thirty (30) days
26 written notification to All Parties or due to unavailability of funding. Termination of the
27 MOA will take effect thirty (30) days following receipt of the written notice of termination.

28
29 **5.0 ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

30 Each YAT will generally consist of one or more DPO, one Sheriff's Deputy or Police Officer,
31 a Deputy District Attorney (DDA), and a contract community based organization (CBO)
32 outreach counselor or public agency who will work in a collaborative effort. The
33 community-based counselor will assist the YAT in youth assessments and provide
34 counseling support to youth and their families.

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1 The management and supervision of YAT is the responsibility of Probation with regular
2 consultation with the participating agencies.

3
4 **5.1 DPO shall:**

- 5 A. Be based in the community at schools, police stations, and/or other community
6 locations;
- 7 B. Accept out-of-custody formal and informal law enforcement referrals;
- 8 C. Provide an intake function for pre-delinquent youth (truants, incorrigibles and
9 curfew violators), and delinquent youth who have committed minor criminal
10 offenses;
- 11 D. Handle referrals in an expeditious manner with a minimal amount of time
12 between the receipt of the referral and the actual meeting with the youth and
13 his/her parent/guardian;
- 14 E. Conduct assessments of youth, develop appropriate rehabilitative plans and
15 refer the youth, family or both, to contract agencies for counseling services;
- 16 F. Supervise cases, counsel youth and their families;
- 17 G. Ensure compliance with behavior contracts or consequence agreements;
- 18 H. Conduct home visits regarding truant or at-risk youth;
- 19 I. Assist in the development of resource lists for community based organizations
20 providing services in the respective areas;
- 21 J. Act as spokesperson and liaison with public and private agencies;
- 22 K. Conduct public information and education sessions;
- 23 L. Attend meetings and other activities to meet the objectives of the program
24 including coordinating parent training and support groups, and participating in
25 field trips and other community resource functions (field trips involving the YAT
26 programs located at the Riverside Unified School District (RUSD) will be
27 coordinated in conjunction with RUSD to meet RUSD transportation
28 requirements);
- 29 M. Work as part of a campus team when assigned to schools; and
- 30 N. Work cooperatively with team members and community agencies.

31
32 **5.2 Sheriff Deputies shall:**

- 33 A. Join the team in contract cities and county locations;
- 34 B. Serve as dedicated YAT deputies where funded; and
- 35 C. Utilize school resource officers (SROs) if needed.

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1 5.3 Police Officers shall:

- 2 A. Join the team in city sites;
3 B. Serve as dedicated YAT officers where funded; and
4 C. Utilize SROs if needed.

5
6 5.4 Law Enforcement Team Members shall:

- 7 A. Join in-home visits, counsel youth and their families in diversion programs, and
8 coordinate YAT referrals with their respective stations;
9 B. Provide expertise in criminal investigations, evidence gathering, suspect
10 identification and apprehension;
11 C. Be prepared, if called upon, to represent the team as a spokesperson and liaison
12 with private and public agencies;
13 D. Assist with truancy sweeps and deal with school truancy problems through the
14 School Attendance Review Board (SARB);
15 E. Represent the team at meetings and other activities as required to meet
16 objectives of the program;
17 F. Conduct public information and education sessions;
18 G. If a SRO on a School site is a YAT member, he/she will assist the team by flexing
19 their hours and leaving campus as needed to accomplish the responsibilities and
20 purposes of the JJCPA Program; and
21 H. Work cooperatively with team members and community agencies.

22
23 5.5 DDA shall:

- 24 A. Provide legal support to the teams, with specific responsibility for participating in
25 the SARB Program, networking with Youth Courts, and assisting with the
26 implementation and execution of the YAT program;
27 B. File petitions in criminal cases involving youth under the jurisdiction of the YAT
28 program when attempts at rehabilitation have been deemed unsuccessful;
29 C. Counsel the youth and family when needed and requested;
30 D. Review applications for petitions to provide the DPO with input regarding
31 eligibility and suitability for participation in the YAT program;
32 E. Be called upon to serve as spokesperson or liaison with public and private
33 agencies, if needed;
34 F. Attend meetings and other activities required to meet objectives of the program;

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- 1 G. Conduct public information and education sessions for youth, families, SRO and
2 other school employees;
- 3 H. Assist in weekly check-ins, school visits and home visits;
- 4 I. Assist with programming in areas such as shoplifting, graffiti, truancy, substance
5 abuse awareness, gang prevention, etc.;
- 6 J. Facilitate "Parent Project," (if trained) and the "Positive Prevention Plus"
7 Program;
- 8 K. Participate in SARB and act as a liaison with school sites and districts on truancy
9 related matters, coordinate with team members on strategies to reduce truancy,
10 conduct DA individual mediations with eligible SARB referred families, and
11 engage in or oversee the prosecution of SARB cases;
- 12 L. Provide law enforcement personnel legal support for truancy sweeps;
- 13 M. Research, plan and develop events and other educational opportunities, such as
14 field trips, tours, or presentations, that will address specific issues for youth and
15 keep team updated on ideas and plans; and
- 16 N. Represent the DA at school and community events and engage in DA approved
17 crime prevention activities that benefit youth.

18
19 **5.6 Unified School Districts shall:**

- 20 A. Support teams by donating office space and necessary equipment (such as
21 phones and desks) for team members and by providing a school staff liaison;
- 22 B. Ensure that designated school personnel will refer to the YAT specific and
23 chronic attendance and behavior problems;
- 24 C. Designate school personnel who will provide student behavior and academic
25 assessments;
- 26 D. Provide necessary available schools services and academic resources for
27 students supervised by YAT;
- 28 E. Identify and provide notification of cases to be presented to SARB; and
- 29 F. Permit access year round to school property, buildings, personnel, students and
30 students' records (including via mobile or internet access) as permitted by law
31 and juvenile court order.

32
33 **6.0 AUDITS**

34 All Parties agree that any duly authorized representative of the Federal, State or County
35 Government shall have the right to audit, inspect, excerpt, copy or transcribe any

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1 pertinent records and documentation relating to this MOA. Any audit exception, as it
2 relates to this MOA, resulting from an audit conducted by any duly authorized
3 representative of the Federal, State or County Government shall be the responsibility of
4 each party.

5
6 **7.0 RECORDS RETENTION**

7 All Parties agree to retain all records pertaining to this MOA for the period indicated in the
8 Riverside County Records Retention General Schedule per Board of Supervisors Policy A-
9 43 unless otherwise indicated by the source of funds. If, at the end of the retention
10 period, there is ongoing litigation or an audit involving those records, each party shall
11 retain the original records until the resolution of such litigation or audit.

12
13 **8.0 CONFIDENTIALITY**

14 All Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all client information in accordance
15 with all applicable Federal, State and local laws and regulations. All parties will ensure
16 names, addresses, phone numbers, and any other individually identifiable information
17 concerning clients and services received are kept confidential.

18
19 **9.0 HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT**

20 All Parties in this MOA are subject to all relevant requirements contained in the Health
21 Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), Public Law 104-191, enacted August
22 21, 1996, and the laws and regulations promulgated subsequent thereto. All Parties agree
23 to cooperate in accordance with the terms and intent of this MOA for implementation of
24 relevant law(s) and/or regulation(s) promulgated under this Law. All Parties agree it shall
25 be in compliance, and shall remain in compliance with the requirements of HIPAA, and the
26 laws and regulations promulgated subsequent hereto, as may be amended from time to
27 time. All Parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth from the Riverside County
28 Board of Supervisors Policy No. B-23.

29
30 **10.0 PERSONNEL DISCLOSURE AND BACKGROUND CHECK PROCEDURES**

31 10.1 Background Check Procedures:

32 Upon request by Probation, All Parties agree to make available to Probation a
33 current list of all personnel that will be providing services under this agreement.
34 This list shall include: all staff who work full-time, part-time, per-diem, or
35 temporarily; a brief description of the functions of each position; and the

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1 professional degree, license (if applicable) and experience required for each
2 position.

3
4 Probation reserves the right to conduct, at any time, background checks on
5 personnel assigned to the YAT program. Based on the background check, Probation
6 shall have the right to require replacement of any personnel. Probation shall be
7 provided immediate written notice of any changes in personnel providing services
8 under this MOA. In the event a background check is conducted, costs associated
9 with the background check will be the responsibility of Probation. In addition,
10 Probation shall have the right at any time to require All Parties to remove or replace
11 any personnel providing services under this MOA for any reason Probation
12 determines to be appropriate.

13
14 **10.2 Disclosure of Information Relevant to Client and Employee Safety:**

15 As required by Penal Code Section 11105.3, All Parties agree to notify Probation of
16 any party's employee assigned to any location that has been convicted of any crimes
17 involving sex, drugs, violence, or felony offense, or who is known to have a
18 substantiated report of child abuse as defined in Penal Code Section 11165.12; who
19 occupy supervisory, teaching or disciplinary power over youth or adult clients.

20
21 Notification procedures for client safety are as follows:

- 22 A. Probation shall notify the party in writing of any person not approved to work
23 with probation clients, but to protect client confidentiality, may not be able to
24 disclose the reason(s) for non-approval.
- 25 B. Upon notification, the party shall immediately remove that person from
26 providing services under this MOA.

27
28 Notification procedures for employee safety are as follows:

- 29 A. When such information becomes known to a party, the party shall immediately
30 notify Probation concerning any arrests or convictions for anything other than
31 minor traffic offenses not withstanding Driving under the Influence or
32 substantiated allegations of abuse by any paid employee.
- 33 B. In the event that notification is made, Probation will make the necessary
34 contractual changes up to and including termination of this MOA.

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1 C. Failure to notify Probation immediately of the above is grounds for termination
2 of individual party from this MOA.
3

4 **11.0 HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION**

5 Each party shall indemnify and hold harmless the other parties from liability or damages
6 resulting from its own actions or omissions including those of its officers or employees in
7 the performance of this agreement.
8

9 **12.0 ASSIGNMENT**

10 This MOA shall not be assigned by any party hereto, either in whole or in part, without
11 prior written consent of Probation. Any assignment or purported assignment of this MOA
12 without the prior written consent will be deemed void and of no force or effect.
13

14 **13.0 LICENSE AND CERTIFICATIONS**

15 All Parties verify upon execution of this MOA, that all work performed pursuant to this
16 MOA will, when applicable, possess a current and valid license/certification in compliance
17 with any local, State, and Federal laws and will be performed by properly trained and
18 licensed/certified staff.
19

20 **14.0 SEVERABILITY**

21 If any provision in this MOA is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void
22 or enforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force without
23 being impaired or invalidated in any way.
24

25 **15.0 COMPENSATION**

26 No Party to this Agreement shall be obligated to pay any monetary compensation to the
27 other. Further no party to this Agreement shall be obligated to pay any third party as a
28 result of this Agreement.
29

30 **16.0 EVALUATION**

31 Probation has contracted for a university researcher to evaluate the JJCPA program as
32 required by law.
33
