WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the California Military Institute has determined that it shall be necessary to eliminate or discontinue the particular kinds of services for lack of work and lack of funds pursuant to Article 19 of the collective bargaining agreement between the California Military Institute and Chapter 778 of the California School Employees Association, as itemized in Exhibit "A," at the close of the current school year; and

WHEREAS, it shall be necessary to terminate and/or reduce hours at the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the employment of certain Classified employees of the California Military Institute as a result of this reduction or discontinuance in particular kinds of services.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the foregoing is true and hereby adopted by the Board of Trustees, and the Principal or designee is directed to send appropriate notices to all employees whose services shall be terminated and/or hours reduced by virtue of this action. Nothing herein shall be deemed to confer any status or rights upon any employee beyond those specifically granted to them by law and/or the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
