




This chart shows the total general purpose revenue Perris Union High School District expects to receive in the coming year from all sources.

The text description for the above chart is as follows: The total revenue projected for Perris Union High School District is \$16,264,309, of which \$14,865,620 is Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), \$1,397,934 is other state funds, \$755 is local funds, and \$ is federal funds. Of the \$14,865,620 in LCFF Funds, \$4,178,041 is generated based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learner, and low-income students).

This chart provides a quick summary of how much Perris Union High School District plans to spend for 2023-24. It shows how much of the total is tied to planned actions and services in the LCAP.


