**WHEREAS**, on June 19, 2024, the CSIU awarded the Contract to Amazon ("Supplier") in accordance with all terms and conditions listed in the bid documents; and

WHEREAS, California Public Contract Code section 20118 authorizes the Board to procure various supplies from Supplier under existing contracts, such as the CSIU Contract, without advertising for bids, if the Board determines it is in the best interest of the District, and the District procures supplies on the same terms and conditions as set forth in the underlying bid;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PERRIS UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, ORDER AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:
