**MODIFICATION**  
 (District's Expense)

This is modification number **two (2)** to Agreement number **IN40035** between **Riverside County Superintendent of Schools** and **Perris Union High School District** to provide **Career Technical Education Services**.

In Accordance with the Amendment clause, the Agreement is modified as follows:

**Section 1 shall read as follows:**

**Full-Time Equivalents:** SUPERINTENDENT'S Career Technical Education Program, upon request of DISTRICT, agrees to employ *ten (10)* Career Technical Education Instructors, at an annual cost of **\$110,114.00**, including salary and benefits per teacher. The Agreement may be amended to cover any increases in salary or benefits for the fiscal year, which are approved and implemented by SUPERINTENDENT.

DISTRICT agrees to employ through contract *ten (10)* instructor(s) in the following programs over the three (3) school years as follows:

Classes noted with an asterisk (\*) are computer based-classes and costs are described in **Attachment B, Computer-Based Classes**.

**Support Services Fee:** DISTRICT shall pay the annual amount of **\$24,000.00** based on the following:

<b>10 or more RCOE CTE Instructors in District</b>	<b>\$24,000.00</b>

**Section 7 shall read as follows:**

**Use of District Property:** DISTRICT agrees to provide DISTRICT property to SUPERINTENDENT for purpose of conducting educational instruction through the Career Technical Education Program within the School District at the following campuses:

**Section 2, COMPENSATION, shall read as follows:**

**COMPENSATION:** DISTRICT agrees to pay SUPERINTENDENT the amount of ***\$1,125,140.00***, said amount being not less than the cost of providing said services, and payable within forty-five (45) days from receipt of an invoice(s). SUPERINTENDENT shall invoice DISTRICT, July 1<sup>st</sup> of each fiscal year.

**All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same.**

- This modification represents an increase in the amount of: ***\$ 191,291.42***
- The total dollar amount of the Agreement, including this change, for year two (2) shall be: ***\$1,125,140.00***

**COMPUTER-BASED CLASSES**
