**RESOLUTION OF THE PERRIS UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT
AUTHORIZING TO APPLY FOR A GRANT WITH THE CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the California Energy Commission's School Bus Replacement Program provides grant funding to public school districts, county offices of education, and joint power authorities to replace old diesel school buses; and

WHEREAS, the Perris Union High School District Governing Board authorizes Candace Reines, Deputy Superintendent of Business Services to apply for school bus grant funding from the California Energy Commission to replace old school buses.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that if recommended for funding by the California Energy Commission, the Perris Union High School District Governing Board authorizes Perris Union High School District to accept a grant for a school bus replacement and vehicle infrastructure.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Candace Reines, Deputy Superintendent of Business Services is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of Perris Union High School District all necessary documents to implement and carry out the purpose of this resolution, and to undertake all actions necessary to undertake and complete the projects.
