- A. The Agencies have solicited proposals for the provision of Produce BID # CN03-1314, whereby the agencies may agree to purchase specified products for their use from the successful bidder(s).
- B. The Service Providers are the successful bidders under the above stated Request for Proposal and the Agencies and Service Providers hereby desire to set forth their agreement with respect to the sale to the Agencies, and the purchase from Service Providers, of products on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

The Service Providers and the Agencies (Las Virgenes Unified School District and Conejo Valley Unified School District) hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Term of Contract: Minimum contract term is one (1) year starting July 1, 2013. Quoted prices must stay in effect for one (1) year after award of bid and may be extended upon mutual consent of the Agencies and vendor for an additional four (4) one year periods in accordance with provisions contained in the California Education Code, Section 17596. In the event of a general price decrease the Agencies reserve the right to revoke the bid unless the decrease is passed on to the Agencies.
- 2. <u>Deliveries:</u> All items ordered under this Agreement shall be delivered F.O.B. destination to the sites listed on the attached sheet on pre-numbered or open purchase orders issued by the Child Nutrition Office of the School District.

- 4. <u>Insurance:</u> Service Provider shall carry and maintain during the entire term of this contract the following insurance coverage:
  - A. INSURANCE Vendor agrees to maintain, at its own expense, occurrence from public liability insurance during the entire term of its agreement(s) to provide goods and/or services to the DISTRICT. The insurance policy shall include, but not limited to, coverage for claims of bodily injury, property damage, and personal injury to protect the DISTRICT against any liability to the public, resulting in any manner from VENDOR'S delivery of goods and/or services to the DISTRICT. VENDOR shall furnish to the DISTRICT a certificate of liability insurance, which contains an additional insured endorsement page, in a form satisfactory to the DISTRICT, from an insurance company approved by the DISTRICT in the amount of ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) to indemnify against the claim of any (1) one occurrence and TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000)

combined single limit in the aggregate. The Certificate of Insurance shall be placed on file with the District at least five (5) business days before any agreement to provide goods and/or services to the District becomes effective. VENDOR is to obtain a written

obligation on the part of the insurance carrier to notify the DISTRICT, in writing, at least thirty (30) days prior to any cancellation thereof. Said Certificate of Insurance and endorsement shall also state that such insurance shall be determined to be primary over any other coverage available to the DISTRICT.

- 5. Indemnification: The Service Provider shall hold harmless, indemnify and defend (with counsel acceptable to the Agencies) the Agencies, the Districts, their boards, directors, employees, agents and consultants from and against any and all obligations, liabilities, claims, losses, damages, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees and costs) arising from or in connection with (a) any defects in food products, (b) Service Provider's conduct or negligent, willful or improper procedures in connection with the discharge of its responsibilities and obligations, or (c) any breach or default by Service Provider under this contract.
- 6. **Provisions Required by Law:** Each and every provision of law and clause inserted into this contract shall be deemed to be inserted herein and this contract shall be read and enforced as though it were included herein, and if through mistake or otherwise any such provision is not inserted or is not inserted correctly, then upon application of either party this contract shall forthwith be physically amended to make such insertion or correction.
- 7. - 1. <u>Preparation of Bids</u>: All proposals must be submitted in ink or typewritten. Both unit price and extension (where applicable) for all line items must be shown where required on the bid form. Signature on bids must be in ink to be considered acceptable. - 2. <u>Tests, Substitutions and Samples</u>: All items bid must conform to the specifications set forth in these documents. The Agency reserves the right to reject all bids that do not conform to the specifications. Suitability and valuation of "equals" rests in the sole discretion of the Agency. Where samples are requested they must be furnished for free.
- 3. <u>Sales Tax</u>: Do not include California State Sales or Use Taxes in unit prices. This tax will be added and paid for by the agency. Do not include or add Federal Excise Tax as the Agency is exempt.
- 4. <u>Cancellation for Insufficient or Non-Appropriated Funds</u>: The bidder agrees and acknowledges that monies utilized by the Agency to purchase the items bid is public money appropriated by the State of California and is subject to variation. The Agency reserves the right to cancel this bid at any time and/or limit quantities of items due to non-availability of sufficient funds.
- 5. Required Delivery Dates: Actual delivery of the specified items will be coordinated with the Agency.
