




This chart shows the total general purpose revenue Perris Union High School District expects to receive in the coming year from all sources.

The text description for the above chart is as follows: The total revenue projected for Perris Union High School District is \$17,447,208, of which \$15,614,393 is Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), \$1,532,415 is other state funds, \$300,400 is local funds, and \$0 is federal funds. Of the \$15,614,393 in LCFF Funds, \$4,294,406 is generated based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learner, and low-income students).

This chart provides a quick summary of how much Perris Union High School District plans to spend for 2024-25. It shows how much of the total is tied to planned actions and services in the LCAP.



#### Increased or Improved Services for High Needs Students in the LCAP for the 2024-25 School Year

In 2024-25, Perris Union High School District is projecting it will receive \$4,294,406 based on the enrollment of foster youth, English learner, and low-income students.
