A **PUBLIC HEARING** has been scheduled before the **Perris Union High School District & California Military Institute Board of Trustees** to consider the matter described below:

PUHSD: Local Control Accountability Plan and Annual Update for 2023-24.

CMI: Local Control Accountability Plan and Annual Update for 2023-24.

The Board of Trustees may adopt revisions to the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) at any time during the period in which the plan is in effect, provided the Board follows the process to adopt the LCAP pursuant to Education Code Section 52062 and the revisions are adopted in a public meeting. In accordance with Education Code 52062, a public hearing shall be held to solicit the recommendations and comments of members of the public regarding the specific revised actions and expenditures proposed to be included in the LCAP.

Ed Code 52062 LCAP (b)(1) A governing board of a school district shall hold a public hearing to solicit the recommendations and comments of members of the public regarding the specific action and expenditures proposed to be included in the local control accountability plan or annual update to the local control accountability plan.

A public hearing will be held for public comment on the proposed revisions to the 2023-24 Local Control Accountability Plan.
