

Joseph Alo, Senior Military Instructor, has submitted fifteen (15) overnight field trip requests for CMI cadets to participate in the following training events during the 2019-20 school year at Camp San Luis Obispo, California:

August 23-25, 2019; September 20-22, 2019; October 18-20, 2019; November 14-17, 2019; December 20-22, 2019, January 24-26, 2020; February 21-23, 2020; March 20-22, 2020; April 24-26, 2020; May 1-3, 2020: CMI has cadets on the California Cadet Corps 10th Corps Cadet State Staff. These cadets are required to attend monthly staff meetings at the military base at Camp San Luis Obispo, in San Luis Obispo, California in order to plan and coordinate California Cadet Corps state events. Approximately five (5) CMI cadets and two (2) adults will depart at 10:00 am on Friday and return to CMI by 7:00 pm on Sunday. Transportation will be provided by a District Vehicle. Cadets will be provided with room and board at Camp San Luis Obispo. There is no cost for cadets attending the monthly California Cadet Corps State Staff Meetings. Transportation will be funded through the California Military Institute CMD-MOU fund in an amount not to exceed \$5,910.00.

September 20-22, 2019: The California Cadet Corps (CACC) Leadership Academy will host a Professional Development for adults and cadets at Camp San Luis Obispo, California. The intent of this program is to inform school administrators, adults, and cadet leadership of the California Cadet Corps. Transportation will be provided by a District Vehicle. Approximately ten (10) students and five (5) adults will attend. Cadets will be provided with room and board at Camp San Luis Obispo. There is no cost for cadets attending the monthly California Cadet Corps State Staff Meetings. Transportation will be funded through the California Military Institute CMD-MOU fund in an amount not to exceed \$578.00.

October 25-27, 2019: The California Cadet Corps (CACC) will host the California Cadet Corps Extreme Challenge at Camp San Luis Obispo, California. The intent of this event is to enhance cadets' physical fitness abilities in a team challenge. Approximately fifty (50) students and five (5) adults attend. Transportation will be provided by bus. Cadets will be provided with room and board at Camp San Luis Obispo. There is no cost for cadets to attend. Transportation will be funded through the California Military Institute CMD-MOU fund in an amount not to exceed \$4,320.00.

November 14-17, 2019: California Cadet Corps Community (CACC) Emergency Response Team (CERT) Training at Camp San Luis Obispo, California. The intent of the CERT training course is to empower each CACC school with a qualified team of cadets and adult leaders equipped with the necessary knowledge and skills to support and play key leadership roles in school emergency response operations during common campus emergencies. Cadets and adult leaders must complete Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) online courses prior to arrival at Camp San Luis Obispo for commencement of training. The online trainings consist of "Introduction to Incident Command System, ICS - 100" and "Intro to Community Emergency Response Teams". The online trainings are at no cost to the cadets. The Cadet Corps is providing food and housing for all cadets attending from the battalions throughout the State. The California Military Institute will provide transportation with three District vehicles. Approximately ten (10) cadets and three (3) adults from CMI will attend the CERT training. Transportation will be provided via District Vehicles and funded through the California Military Institute CMD-MOU fund in an amount not to exceed \$877.00.

April 17-19, 2020: The California Cadet Corps (CACC) will host the California Cadet Corps State Drill Competition and State Individual Major Awards Competition at Camp San Luis Obispo, California. The intent of this event is to enhance cadets' marching skills, academic, public speaking and physical fitness in a competitive environment. Approximately sixty five (65) students and six (6) adults will leave on Friday,

April 17th at 5:00 am and return to CMI on Sunday, April 19, 2019 at 7:00 pm. Transportation will be provided by two (2) buses and three (3) vans. Cadets will be provided with room and board at Camp San Luis Obispo. There is no cost for cadets to attend. Transportation will be funded through the California Military Institute CMD-MOU fund in an amount not to exceed \$3,940.00.

May 1-3, 2020: The California Cadet Corps (CACC) will host the California Cadet Corps State Individual Major Awards Competition at Camp San Luis Obispo, California. The intent of this event is to enhance cadets' general knowledge of the California Cadet Corps competition environment. Approximately ten (10) students and five (5) adults will leave on Friday, May 1, 2019 at 6:00 am and return to CMI on Sunday, April 19, 2019 at 3:00 pm. Transportation will be provided by two (2) vans. Cadets will be provided with room and board at Camp San Luis Obispo. There is no cost for cadets to attend. Transportation will be funded through the California Military Institute CMD-MOU fund in an amount not to exceed \$580.00.
