

**ITEM: CONSENT: CURRICULUM:** Overnight Field Trips – Perris High School's Future Farmers of America Students to Attend Various Agriculture Field Days in the Months of February 2019 and April 2019 (funded through Heritage High School's Perkins Grant Fund, Categorical and Student Body Fund, not the General Fund)

**SUMMARY:**

Douglas Cousins, Heritage High School Agriculture Future Farmers of America Advisor, has submitted seven (7) overnight field trip requests for members of the Perris High School's Future Farmers of America (FFA) students to attend the following FFA Field Day events during the months of February to April 2019:

Arbuckle Field Day at Pierce High School - February 1-3, 2019: Participants include 16 students and 2 chaperones. This event is a competitive event that prepares students with skills that can be used in the workforce. Our teams spend countless hours practicing and studying to prepare for these events. Each event also has a public speaking component which helps students to become more confident in their speaking and presentation skills. These teams provide students with the opportunity to acquire skills that can be used in real life. Cost per student/adult is \$50 each with the approximate total cost not to exceed \$900. Transportation will be provided by district vehicles.

Dinuba Field Day @ Dinuba High School - March 15-16, 2019: Participants include 4 students and 1 chaperone. This event is a competitive event that prepares students with skills that can be used in the workforce. Our teams spend countless hours practicing and studying to prepare for these events. Each event also has a public speaking component which helps students to become more confident in their speaking and presentation skills. These teams provide students with the opportunity to acquire skills that can be used in real life. Cost per student/adult is \$75 each with the approximate total cost not to exceed \$375. Transportation will be provided by district vehicles.

U.C. Davis Field Day – March 1-3, 2019: Participants include 25 students and 4 adult chaperones. This event will be held at the University of California (UC) Davis for their annual Career Development Event/Field Day. The UC Davis event is one of the two largest state level California Department of Education (CDE) FFA event of the year. The top teams will be competing at this event in preparation for the state finals competition in May. Students will be exposed to this top agricultural university while learning more about their contests and competing at the highest level in the state. Students will be exposed to the university atmosphere which will help motivate them to work hard towards their goals for their future careers. Students will develop hands-on leadership skills as they interact with other students, judges, and teachers at their competition sites. Cost per student/adult is \$50 each with the approximate total cost not to exceed \$1660. Transportation will be provided by district vehicles.

Chico Field Day Competition – March 8-10, 2019: Participants include 16 students and 4 adult chaperones. This event will be held at Chico State University, in Chico, California. The Chico FFA Field Day event is one of the two largest state level Career Development Event (CDE) of the year. The top teams will be competing at this event in preparation for the state finals competition in May. FFA members attending the Chico FFA Field Day Competition will be able to visit with other FFA members from throughout the state, as well as leaders from other states and the National FFA. Attendees will focus on the following objectives: participate in Career Development Event that will enhance their skills, develop leadership skills through interaction with other members, receive awards and honors for hard work and achievement in their contest area, and be exposed to the university setting and experience new places. Cost per student/adult is \$50 each with the approximate total cost not to exceed \$1600. Transportation will be provided by district vehicles.

Merced College Field Day – March 15-16, 2019: Participants include 25 students and 4 adult chaperones. This event is a competitive event that prepares students with skills that can be used in the workforce. Our teams spend countless hours practicing and studying to prepare for these events. Each event also has a public speaking component which helps students to become more confident in their speaking and presentation skills. These teams provide students with the opportunity to acquire skills that can be used in real life. Cost per student/adult is \$30 each with the approximate total cost not to exceed \$870. Transportation will be provided by district vehicles.

Reedley College Field Day @ Reedley College - March 29-30, 2019: Participants include 5 students and 2 chaperone. This event is a competitive event that prepares students with skills that can be used in the workforce. Our teams spend countless hours practicing and studying to prepare for these events. Each event also has a public speaking component which helps students to become more confident in their speaking and presentation skills. These teams provide students with the opportunity to acquire skills that can be used in real life. Cost per student/adult is \$220 each with the approximate total cost not to exceed \$1320. Transportation will be provided by district vehicles.

Fresno Field Day and State Speaking Finals - April 12-13, 2019; Participants include 25 students and 3 adult chaperones. The Fresno Field Day Event and State Speaking Finals is a career development event. This is a competitive team that prepares students with skills that can be used in the workforce. Our teams spend countless hours practicing and studying to prepare for these events. Each event also has a public speaking component which helps students become more confident in their speaking skills. These teams provide students with the opportunity to acquire skills that can be used in “real life”. Cost per student/adult is \$65 each with the approximate total cost not to exceed \$1400. Transportation will be provided by district vehicles. Exposure to competition at the four events will enhance HHS students’ ability to perform at a higher level and will enhance skills and knowledge in their given contests. It will also enable students to earn higher awards and placement in future competitions.

**FUNDING:**

The cost for these items (includes all 7 trips) is included in the 2018-19 Perris High School Associated Student Body (ASB) operating budget, the Perkins Grant, and AIF Site Funds. funded.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the overnight field trip request for Perris High School Future Farmers of America to attend these Agriculture Field Days events in February 2019, March 2019, and April 2019.
