The College and Career Readiness Department of RCOE will provide and maintain guidance and project management through ongoing digital, voice, and face-to-face communication for the duration of the contract.

The College and Career Readiness Department of RCOE will analyze the transcripts of Heritage High School's Class of 2024 students using the A-G completion criteria.

The College and Career Readiness Department of RCOE will generate both spreadsheet and summary reports. The reports will include student demographic information.

PUHSD will provide RCOE with a PDF copy of each student's transcript and the demographic information for the student transcripts being analyzed. RCOE will provide the demographic file specifications and a secure file upload link for the transcripts and the demographic file.

Business Rules for High School Transcript Analysis

- The transcripts of the Class of 2024 will be analyzed
- Estimated Total High School Students 600
- All A-G Courses will be entered
- Letter grades to classes will be entered for all grade-level A-G classes (A, B, C, D, F)
- Credit/Pass marks on transcripts will be entered as "C" grades
- No Credit/Fail marks on transcripts will be entered as "F" grades
- Non A-G classes will be entered using the mark of "N"
- The district office will provide a digital file of transcripts for the school
- RCOE will provide a secure upload link for transcripts

RCOE staff will enter the student transcripts to generate detailed student and school summary reports.	
RCOE will combine grade distribution and demographic data to create the reports.
