PERRIS UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 29:21-22

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN PRODUCTS, BRANDS, OR SERVICES, PURSUANT TO PUBLIC CONTRACT CODE SECTION 3400 TO STANDARDIZE DISTRICT BRANDS

WHEREAS, the Perris Union High School District ("District") is a California public school district subject to the California Public Contract Code ("PCC");

WHEREAS, pursuant to PCC section 3400 and other applicable law, the District's Board of Education ("Board") may make a finding that designates certain products, brands, or services for District improvements in order for the District to standardize or match certain brands;

WHEREAS, based on review of PCC section 3400, and in order to standardize brands, the Board desires to designate Dunn-Edwards Paints ("Dunn-Edwards") paint products for District projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board resolves, determines, and orders as follows:

- **Section 1.** The recitals above are true and correct.
- **Section 2.** The District, pursuant to PCC section 3400, intends to establish uniform, complete, and compatible standards for paint projects District-wide.
- **Section 3.** The District has found that the compatibility, durability, quality, and utility of paint products is critical to painting projects and using a paint product within these standards is important to avoid costs associated with incompatibility, durability, and reliability issues.
- **Section 4.** The District's existing facilities already use Dunn-Edwards paint products throughout the District, which will need to be matched for continuity of District operations for future District paint projects.
- **Section 5.** The ongoing maintenance, repair, and other painting-related work that District staff and/or service providers will have to perform will be simplified, more efficient, and less costly if those persons do not have to use and procure different and varied products.
- **Section 6.** The District has researched the paint products and brands suitable to serve the District's facilities needs.
- **Section 7.** The District has determined that Dunn-Edwards paint products exhibit long-lasting quality and durability and the District has found that Dunn-Edwards has favorable manufacturer support services and product warranties. Additionally, particularly for the uses of graffiti repainting, painting of sanitary facilities and paint-related repairs between buildings and sites, achieving consistent coloring to avoid the need to over-repaint, is important to District needs.

Section 8. The Board designates the products, brands, and services specified below to establish a District-wide standard for the following reasons:

A. <u>Painting</u>: Dunn-Edwards paint products are necessary because: Standardization will provide uniformity throughout the District resulting in cost savings and consistency related to future District paint projects.

Section 9. The Board delegates authority to District staff to take all actions necessary to effect the intent of this resolution, including, but not limited to, describing the District's findings in invitations for bids.

Section 10. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
