

# RIVERSIDE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM – BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CARE SOLACE WEBSITE PILOT PROGRAM

### DISTRICT NAME: PERRIS UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT (PUHSD)

This agreement is by and between the Riverside University Health System – Behavioral Health, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and Perris Union High School District (PUHSD), hereinafter referred to as DISTRICT, to provide funding for the implementation of the Care Solace Website Pilot Program, hereinafter referred to as PROGRAM, which is effective January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019. The parties agree to the following:

# DISTRICT: Perris Union High School District (PUHSD) PROGRAM: Care Solace Website Implementation FUNDING TERM: January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019

#### <u>Overview</u>

COUNTY will provide funding to DISTRICT for the cost of DISTRICT's implementation of the Care Solace Website Pilot Program. DISTRICT will implement the Care Solace website, which will provide students, parents, and staff with direct, personalized access to a system that has been designed to provide customized support services for those experiencing Mental Health and Substance Abuse issues. Services include: Search for Treatment Centers, Personalized Case Management, and Monitoring of Treatment Centers for availability.

By providing funding to implement the program, COUNTY is not agreeing to provide technical assistance, oversight or services related to the Care Solace Website Program, nor does COUNTY assume any liability for the website's operation or performance.

### **DISTRICT Implementation and Training Responsibility**

DISTRICT will ensure the Care Solace website and Training is implemented - as stated in the proposal:

- Onsite training at any district or school location 20-30 minutes each session (typically 2-3 sessions in total);
- Site Administration will be contacted to arrange convenient times for training;
- Stakeholders included at each site: site admin, counselors, mental health workers, student support services, psych's, nurses and HR staff;
- Additional staff support for training via Google Hangouts (a simple link without any login or software needed to see us live and our screens) ;
- All materials and handouts will be emailed with hard copies passed out at onsite trainings; and,
- All digital postcards are to be mailed to each site location that has a district customized link.
