

Resolution No. 23:21-22
RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PERRIS UNION HIGH
SCHOOL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING PROCUREMENT OF
STRUCTURED CABLING SERVICES
(PUBLIC CONTRACT CODE SECTION 20118.2)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (“Board”) of the Perris Union High School District (“District”) desires to procure structured cabling services to re-cable certain buildings throughout the District (“Project”);

WHEREAS, due to the highly specialized and unique nature of technology and related equipment and services, because technology is undergoing rapid changes, and in order to allow for the introduction of new technological changes in the operation of school districts, Public Contract Code section 20118.2 allows school districts to consider, in addition to price, factors such as financing, performance reliability, standardization, life-cycle costs, delivery timetables, support logistics, warranties, and similar factors in the award of contracts for technology and related equipment and services;

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code section 20118.2 requires the Board to make a finding that the District's purchase qualifies under Section 20118.2 and that utilizing the procurement method set forth in the statute is in the best interest of the District for the Project;

WHEREAS, the structured cabling services is a project eligible for E-rate funding;

WHEREAS, the District prepared a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) for structured cabling services;

WHEREAS, the District received seven responses to the RFP, and evaluated responses pursuant to the evaluation criteria listed in those documents, including the cost of services, vendor references, experience and knowledge, methodology, and service level;

WHEREAS, the District has evaluated responses, finds that the proposal submitted by GA Technical Services (“GA Tech”) is most advantageous to the District with price and all other factors considered, and desires to enter a contract (“Contract”) with GA Tech to complete the re-cabling of certain buildings throughout the District;

WHEREAS, the cost of the contract is \$248,720.00;

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code section 20118.2 requires that, if an award is not made to the bidder whose proposal contains the lowest price, the school district must make a finding setting forth the basis for the award;

WHEREAS, the proposed form of the Contract is available in the District’s Business Services Office;

WHEREAS, a school district may delegate the authority to enter into contracts to the district superintendent or his or her designee, pursuant to Education Code section 17604; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to delegate to the Superintendent’s designee, the Deputy Superintendent of Business Services, Candace Reines (“Designee”), the authority to finalize, execute and deliver the Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Perris Union High School District hereby finds, determines and orders as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
2. The Board finds that it is in the District’s best interest to utilize the competitive negotiation procurement method outlined in Public Contract Code section 20118.2 to afford the District the flexibility and evaluation of factors permitted for the procurement of technology and related equipment and services for the Project.
3. The District finds that procurement of structured cabling services qualifies and is authorized under Public Contract Code section 20118.2.
4. The District finds that, despite not providing the lowest price, considering all factors evaluated by the District during the RFP process, including the cost services, vendor references, experience and knowledge, methodology, and service level, GA Tech meets the project’s requirements, satisfies the District’s RFP, and would provide the District with the most advantageous services that fit within the scope of services sought under the RFP.
5. The District awards the contract for structured cabling services to GA Tech.
6. The Board delegates authority to the District’s Designee to execute and deliver the Contract with such additions, amendments, and revisions as are recommended or approved by Designee and counsel to the District, and to take any related actions necessary.
7. The authority given in this Resolution shall be deemed retroactive and all acts taken by District employees and consultants with respect to the Contract performed prior to the approval of this Resolution are hereby confirmed, ratified and affirmed.
